## Call for applications: Module leader

The Milestone Institute aims to expand its teaching staff and academic expertise in a range of positions and academic disciplines. The Institute is currently advertising the position of module leader.

### **General Experience**

While the specific experience and skills required for each position are listed on the next page, the following criteria apply to all applicants:

#### *Required Experience:*

- Native or near native-level English-language competence, particularly in-depth knowledge of the academic vocabulary of a given field or discipline of expertise
- Completed degree at a UK and/or US university and/or substantial teaching experience at tertiary or/and secondary level in English

#### *Desired Experience (any of the following):*

- A bachelor, postgraduate degree and/or postdoctoral research experience at a leading university based in the UK or US.
- Strong research background and record of publications.
- Institutional affiliation or/and working relationship with Hungarian or/and international universities or research centres.
- Institutional affiliation or/and working relationship with Hungarian or/and international NGOs.
- Institutional affiliation or/and working relationship with Hungarian or/and international preparatory and/or secondary schools.
- In-depth understanding of the application process to UK and US universities at undergraduate level.
- In-depth understanding of the application process to UK and US undergraduate and graduate scholarships.
- Third and/or fourth language competence besides English and Hungarian.



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## Module leader

**Purpose of the position:** module leaders teach small groups of students (numbering 6-12), both within the bounds of a particular discipline and in an interdisciplinary (i.e. thematic) manner. The Institute is looking for expertise in the fields of natural sciences and engineering, social sciences (from economics to social anthropology), humanities (from classics and history to literature) and arts (from architecture and fine art to film and theatre studies).

Throughout the four-year programme, module leaders have the opportunity to teach a student body that ranges in age from 14 to 19, within the context of 4- or 8-week modules. Within these, module leaders should aim to:

- Develop key academic skills – critical thinking, research skills, academic writing, debating and presentation skills, as well as an in-depth knowledge of subjects.
- Broaden the students' horizons and orient and inspire them to take up a particular area of undergraduate study.
- Demonstrate the connections between academic disciplines and the importance of an interdisciplinary perspective.
- Help students become internationally competitive in their academic knowledge.
- Communicate the values outlined by the institute about the nature of academic study and the broader importance of social solidarity, scientific innovation and a balanced, democratic political culture.
