Safety Measures for On-Site Student Life Events For Student Leaders and Students

Due to the epidemic situation, offline Student Life events in the Summer Term will be held in the courtyard of the Milestone Institute, with a limit of 20 students participating in each event. In case of bad weather, we can also provide an alternative indoor location, the gymnasium downstairs. The third and fourth floors of the Institute are currently unavailable for Student Life events.

The planned duration of each event is a maximum of 2 hours. Upon arrival, we would like to ask all participants to go directly to the courtyard area. A member of the Reception team will be there to welcome you at the start of events and will also be there at the end of sessions.

Please note that all participants are asked to wear a mask throughout the events. We also kindly ask you to place the seats at a safe distance (1.5 meters) from each other and keep that specified distance from each other throughout your stay.

Water and disposable paper cups will be provided for events, please place used cups in the bins after use. A hand-sanitiser station will also be provided in the courtyard. There are two bathrooms on the ground floor of the building, situated in the internal staircase area. When using the bathrooms, please make sure you observe the following rules of usage:

- Please always wear a mask during your stay at the Institute.
- Before and after using the bathroom, please use the hand sanitizer gel in addition to washing your hands.
- After using the toilet, please disinfect the toilet seat, the button and the tap with the disinfectant spray you find in the bathroom.

Other recommendations

- If you have the opportunity, please choose an individual form of transportation to get to Milestone, such as walking, cycling or travelling by car.
- In case you do use public transportation, please keep the applicable regulations there as well, such as wearing a mask, keeping a distance of 1.5 meters from others, wearing gloves (optionally).
